Invitation

We invite you to submit your research papers for presentation at the 3rd International Scientific Conference entitled: Greece - Europe 2030: Education, Research, Innovation, New Technologies, Institutions, and Sustainable Development. The aim of the Conference is to present new research on the economic dimensions of the fields of Education, Lifelong Learning, Research, New Technologies, Innovation, and their relations with the Economy.

The conference is co-organised by the Hellenic Institute of Economics of Education, Lifelong Learning, Research & Innovation, the Hellenic Mediterranean University, and the Hellenic Open University.

Submission of Papers

Those interested in participating in the conference with a scientific paper or a poster presentation are invited to submit an abstract of their paper written in English or Greek to the email: **inoek2023@inoek.gr** by **30 June 2023**. The abstract, which should be between 300 and 500 words, should present the aim and objectives of the work, the methodology of the approach, the applications, and the main results. The abstract should include the following information: (1) title of the paper, (2) name(s) of the author(s), postal address, and email. All abstracts will go through the anonymous review system. Due to the international nature of the conference, those interested in submitting a paper are requested to indicate whether the paper will be presented in English or Greek.

Proceedings of the Conference

Those wishing to have their paper included in the Proceedings of the Conference should submit completed research papers in Greek or in English, until **30 July 2023**, through the platform of the National Documentation Centre. All papers will go through the double anonymous review

system. The Proceedings of the 3rd Conference will be published electronically through the ePublishing service of the National Documentation Centre (<https://eproceedings.epublishing.ekt.gr/>), as was the case with the publication of the Proceedings of the 1st and 2nd Conference (see the Proceedings at: <https://eproceedings.epublishing.ekt.gr/index.php/inoek>). It should be noted that, at the authors' risk, any paper submitted for publication in the Proceedings of the Conference through the ePublishing service is excluded from the possibility of publication in another scientific publication.

Publication of Papers

Papers presented at the conference may be submitted, under the responsibility of their authors, to one of the following journals:

- (b) Creative Education (see <https://www.scirp.org/journal/CE>),
- (c) South-Eastern Europe Journal of Economics (SEEJE) (see <http://www.asecu.gr/Seeje/>).

The deadline for submission of papers is 31 October 2023. All submitted papers must be in English and will be evaluated using the double-blind referee evaluation system.

Declaration of Participation

The participation fee for the Conference is 10€ in person and 25€ remotely. For unemployed persons and students, it is free of charge. For paper presenters 20€. Includes attendance of papers, printed material, coffee, and light lunch.

Registration for the conference should be requested by **August 20, 2023**, by email to inoek2023@inoek.gr. The registration form must be accompanied by the relevant information on the payment of the participation fee to the account of INOEK at the National Bank of Greece (Account No.: 053/481002-30, IBAN: GR7201100530000005348100230).

Especially for the papers that will be accepted for presentation at the Conference, and in order to be included in the programme, at least one of the authors must be registered as a co-author by 20 August 2023.
